Working bee and renovations

They may also be asked by the elected house captain to perform additional duties, such as cleaning windows, vacuuming communal areas and clearing snow around emergency exit points. Outside peak season there is no cleaner employed, and it is crucial that guests leave the lodge spotless during this period for the comfort of future guests. This allows us to keep the rates at Yalara low.
