Vail Resorts acquires Perisher!

In the biggest news in the Australian ski industry in a lona time, Vail Resorts has announced plans to buy Perisher for \$176 million. The deal, which is subject to government approval, means people who buy a \$749 Freedom Pass for Perisher will also have access to Vail's nine US resorts. The pass will include ten days of skiing and riding at Vail and Beaver Creek in Colorado, as well as unlimited skiing at Breckenridge, Keystone and Arapahoe Basin in Colorado, Park City and Canyons in Utah and Heavenly, Northstar and Kirkwood in the Lake Tahoe area of California and Nevada. The offer is subject to certain holiday restrictions.

Ski removal
